The Department of Social and Behavioral Sciences is seeking a person qualified to teach in its Psychology and Counseling division who will be dedicated to the development of these disciplines at Faulkner University. The teaching responsibilities will be at the graduate and undergraduate level which may include theories, clinical skills, human development, research, etc., depending upon the candidate's interest and program needs. The candidate will actively engage in student advisement, supervision of practica and internship students, and assist the Master's Program Coordinator in the graduate studies program.

The candidate's academic rank for this position will be based upon educational and experiential qualifications according to University policy. The successful candidate must demonstrate a commitment to Christ-centered Liberal Arts education, Christian service, the mission of Faulkner University and the mission of the Department of Social and Behavioral Sciences.

This is a 9-month position. The position will be available Fall of 2012. This position is pending funding. Applications will be accepted until the position is filled. The review of applications will begin immediately. Employment is conditional upon a satisfactory background check.

#### ***Qualifications:***

- A PhD in Counseling from a regionally accredited institution; a terminal degree from a CACREP program is preferred
- Minimum of two years of clinical experience and experience in undergraduate and/or graduate education required
- Record of scholarly publications and research agenda preferred
- Experience in distance-based learning environments preferred
- Must be an active member of the church of Christ
