**LATE REGISTRATION POLICY**

Students will **NOT** be allowed to register for any class that has met more than one time, *i.e.*, students may register for a class if he/she has missed only one class session. If a class is missed prior to enrolling, that class will count towards Faulkner University's 25% attendance rule.

**ADD-DROP/WITHDRAWAL POLICY<sup>2</sup>**

A student may **drop** a course or **withdraw** from school (drop all courses) *without academic penalty* through the date identified in the Academic Calendar of each program as the "**last day to drop a class with a W.**" During this period of time a student may drop a course by completing a Drop form and securing the appropriate signatures. Drop forms may be obtained from the Registrar's Office, and must be returned before the time noted in the Academic Calendar. A student withdrawing from school (all courses) must obtain a Withdrawal form from the Registrar's Office and must secure all signatures indicated on the form. Withdrawal is not official until the student submits the completed form to the Business Office (last step in the withdrawal procedure) for processing. **All drops/withdrawals after the time noted will result in a grade of "F",** which will adversely affect the grade point average. **A student has not officially withdrawn from a class or from school until the proper forms have been filed with the appropriate offices. In addition, tuition is charged, or refunded, according to the appropriate program Refund Policy in the official Faulkner University catalog.**
