



## Adjunct Instructors

Faulkner University is seeking to add to its pool of qualified individuals who would like to teach courses. This is an open invitation to apply for the University's Adjunct Instructor Candidate Pool. Individuals with experience and appropriate degrees in instructional areas offered at Faulkner University are encouraged to apply.

Candidates must be available on a part time basis to augment the instructional opportunities and needs for Faulkner daytime, evening and weekend credit courses in both on- and off-campus settings. Adjunct instructors are needed for courses taught on the Montgomery Campus, as well as in our Military Education Program and Community Partner locations across the state of Alabama.

Instructors with pre-identified competencies will be chosen from the Adjunct Instructor Candidate Pool to participate in additional application/selection processes as specific needs arise for credit courses and project assignments. Adjunct instructors may be employed to teach courses, make presentations, and provide facilitation or other service activities.

### Application Criteria

In order to be considered for the Adjunct Instructor Candidate Pool, applicants are required to possess:

- A minimum of a Master's Degree in the field of instruction

**OR**

- A Master's Degree in a related field, **plus**
- 18 graduate level hours in the discipline

Faulkner University departments will set up their own criteria for selecting and approving candidates that include, but are not limited to:

- Significant, applied experience within the professional setting of intended instruction
- Teaching experience and past performance
