DESCRIPTION:

Encourage our youth and their families in their walk with Christ through teaching, shared experiences, mentoring and various activities.

CHARACTER EXPECTATIONS:

A minister is expected to embrace the fundamental tenets of the Christian faith. As a covenant child of God, he will manifest a Christlikeness through faithfulness to the Lord and dedication to His church. Evidence of this commitment will be exhibited by, but not confined to:

- *Faithful worship and Bible class participation
- *Being a ministry “team player” showing a willingness to help/partner with other ministers, servants, and members of the Airport Rd. congregation
- *A spirit of humility and service that is consistent with being a leader in the Lord’s church
- *An overall commitment to the vision and purpose of the Lord’s church and the flock that gathers at Airport Rd.

FUNCTIONAL EXPECTATIONS:

1. Will teach a youth Bible class at least three quarters per year either for Sunday A.M. Bible class or Wednesday evening Bible study or both.
2. Coordinate spiritually focused youth activities throughout the year such as devotionals and youth rallies/seminars
3. Coordinate social youth activities throughout the year
4. Make in home visits with youth and their families on a regular and as needed basis.
5. Will preach at regular intervals as determined by ministry staff/elders.
6. Will fill-in for the senior minister in the pulpit when necessary
7. Will attend elder's and/or deacon's meetings as required.
8. Other duties and responsibilities as assigned
