- 1. It cannot be designated as a State-approved degree for certification purposes.
- 2. It will not lead to a Class A: Master's degree-level program.
- 3. It cannot be used as the basis of admission into a Class AA: sixth year level or education specialist degree-level program as it does not lead to Class A certification.

I also acknowledge the following:

- 1. No representations have been made to me as to how this degree would be treated in other states in terms of the specific matters herein discussed.
- 2. No representations have been made to me that this program may be reconsidered in the future by ALSDE (or any other department of education of any other state) and thus become eligible for becoming a State-approved degree for certification purposes.
- 3. Once I have enrolled in this program at Faulkner, I cannot shift to another graduate program at within the College of Education at Faulkner. For example, a candidate cannot begin in the Curriculum and Instruction Program and then move to the Traditional Class A program.
