- Communicating effectively with parents and caregivers regarding the child's progress and any concerns that may arise.
- Participating in team meetings and contributing to the development of strategies and interventions to support the child's growth and development.
- Supporting and promoting inclusive activities that engage the child with their peers and foster social interaction.
- Follow ECDC, FUMC and DHR policies.
- Participates and supports fundraising events on and off campus.
- Performs other duties, as requested.
