JOB DESCRIPTION

The Youth Minister is responsible for developing a comprehensive youth ministry that aligns with the church's overall mission. Collaborating closely with the elders, youth deacons, and parents, he aims to cultivate a ministry that empowers, enriches, and actively engages each student in their spiritual walk and personal growth.

Qualifications:

- Is a Biblically based and spirit-filled Christian.
- Has completed the necessary educational courses and/or the equivalent to lead in the area of youth ministry.
- Has experience working with youth in a ministerial role.

Job Description/Expectations:

- Plan, coordinate, and teach a Biblical curriculum that addresses the spiritual and growth needs of our students in collaboration with the elders & youth deacons.
- Plan and coordinate retreats, service projects, Bible studies, devotionals, and mission efforts to promote faith development in our students.
- Attend the annual Lads to Leaders convention with those youth who participate.
- Work with youth deacons to prepare, maintain, and work within an annual HYG budget and youth calendar.
- Maintains an open line of communication with the elders and ensures they are aware of all youth activities.
- Inform the elders and youth deacons of any problems that arise with any individual student or situations that might influence a student's family or involvement.
- Values singing in worship experiences with students and teaching new songs.
- Works with the elders and other ministers to develop and maintain a summer youth internship program.

- Serve as a role model, mentor, and encourager for our students
- Be engaged in church-wide activities to foster a healthy connection to the church family
- Attend and encourage students' extracurricular activities.
- Stay connected to and collaborate with other youth ministers in the area.
- Should possess the gifts and capabilities for building relationships with students and their families, for skillful teaching of God's word in ways relevant to teenagers, and for leadership of a spiritually formative youth ministry program.
- Should be a strong self-motivator, able to take initiative in the development and leadership of the youth program.
- Should be a capable communicator, able to coordinate with parents and volunteers about plans and opportunities to serve.
- Should seek opportunities for advancing skills (training seminars, workshops, etc.)
