Employee Discounts & Referral Program

Full-time employees' children, stepchildren, and grandchildren (including step-grandchildren) seeking a traditional undergraduate degree (on-ground at our Montgomery campus) may receive a minimum guaranteed \$10,000 scholarship/grant.

Executive Dependent Discount

A full-time employees' adult children, stepchildren, and grandchildren (including step-grandchildren) may receive a 50% tuition discount for eligible programs.

- Must provide a letter from employer on letterhead verifying full-time employment prior to initial enrollment
