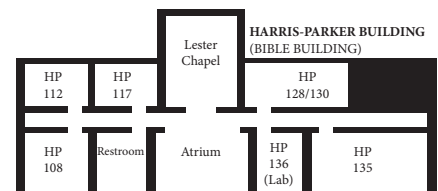
Campus Map

There will be a Seminar focusing on athletes on Monday. On Tuesday there will be Digital Ministry Workshop, Ethics Institute Seminar, and Homeschooling Seminar. On Wednesday, Vocational Ministry Seminar will take place. The College of Education will provide childcare services for the week. All the keynote speeches will take place in the Rotunda; all Chapel services will be in Tine Davis Gymnasium.
