Mr. Alfonzo Williams



Alfonzo Williams is the first African-American sheriff of Burke County and first African-American police chief of the City of Waynesboro Police Department. He has 31 years of law enforcement experience, starting with the Augusta Police Department and Richmond County Sheriff's Office. Over the course of his career, he received six Police Officer of the Year awards from various civic organizations and law enforcement agencies. Williams worked for various other law enforcement agencies, including Waynesboro Police Department, Burke County Sheriff's Office, Columbia County Sheriff's Office, District Attorney's Office, Augusta Technical College, Richmond County Schools and the State Police Academy.

On January 1, 2017, Williams was sworn in as sheriff of Burke County

to serve a four-year term after receiving 72% of the vote. He was re-elected and sworn in to serve a second four-year term beginning on January 1, 2021.

Williams has an Associate of Applied Technology in Criminal Justice from Augusta Technical College (2001), a Bachelor of Science in Organizational Management from Voorhees College (2005), a Master of Education (Instructional Technology) from American InterContinental University (2006) and a Master of Justice Administration from Faulkner University (2019).

Williams has taught full and part time with Augusta Technical College as a criminal justice instructor. He is married to Shirleta Williams, and the couple has one daughter together, Chandler Williams. Kiara Williams is his oldest daughter. He is a member of the Forest Hill Baptist Church where he formerly served eight years as chairman of the deacon board ministry.

In 2020, Williams wrote three books: *Not Here to be Served, Police on Policing: The Unsung Consensus*, and *Murder In Augusta*. His fourth book, *Truth Has No Color*, is expected to be published by July 2021.

Williams said, "The Bible says, 'The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many.' I am here to serve mankind."

President David R. Shannon



David R. Shannon is the 16th president of Freed-Hardeman University. During his tenure, enrollment and fundraising have set new records, and the University has successfully launched a \$93M comprehensive campaign.

Before coming to Freed Hardeman University, Shannon was a fulltime gospel minister. Since 1989, he served two congregations of churches of Christ in Alabama and Tennessee. During his time at each, both congregations doubled in attendance. Preaching and teaching are two of his passions. He has conducted leadership, marriage, parenting and church growth seminars, held Gospel meetings, spoken at youth events, and traveled on evangelistic campaigns. He has spoken approximately 500 times each year for each of the last several years

while in full-time ministry. Yet some of his favorite times were studying the Bible with one or two people at a time. A practice begun in his mid-20s, he has studied the Bible weekly with unbelievers, an evangelistic challenge from the late Jerry Jenkins of the former Roebuck Parkway church of Christ.

In 2016, Shannon shared a dream with four other ministers who together created the "One Word" devotional book and the "One Word Study Guide" that sold more than 30,000 copies during the first year. He co-authored a study guide on how to become a Christian, entitled "Access to God," with an estimated printing of more than 60,000 copies.

Shannon graduated from Freed-Hardeman College in 1989 with a B.S. degree in Finance and a minor in Bible. He and his wife, Tracie, have been married for more than 30 years, have five children, and six grandchildren.

Green and purple cord denotes membership in Kappa Delta Pi, an international Education honor society.

Platinum and dark blue cord denotes membership in Psi Chi, an international Psychology honor society. **Black and platinum cords** denote membership in The National Society of Leadership and Success.
