	Retention Rate = Number registered in Term 1 minus number who matriculated/leveled over before term 2, minus Total Number Graduated (= Total Potential Returnees).

	Executive Business Programs: The 5 Executive Business programs are individually designed under a format which, depending on the degree plan, may range in program duration from one-year to a 16 month program. In addition, semesters and courses occur consecutive and are year round. The methodology for calculating the retention rate for the 5 Executive Business Programs was determined as follows:
Retention	Retention Rate = Individual students registered in fall, spring, and summer semesters minus (-) individual students, either withdrawn or administratively dismissed from an Executive Program.
	Retention includes students completing an Executive Program during the Academic Year plus (+) Students (new and/or continuing) enrolled beginning fall, spring, or summer semesters and still enrolled or graduated by the completion of summer semester.
	Retention Loss = Students withdrawn from program or academically dismissed from period beginning fall semester through end of summer semester.
