Complete a clinical internship of nine months of full-time professional employment under a licensed supervisor, unless in an exempt setting; the supervisor must have ASHA Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC) or equivalent;
Passage of the Praxis Exam by ETS; Complete jurisprudence online orientation
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STATE VERIFICATION:

Has New Jersey verified the above determination made by Faulkner University?

"Please be advised that per statutes/regulations of the committee, an applicant for licensure must submit to the committee proof that he/she has graduated from a doctoral degree program or a masters degree program in the area of audiology or speech language pathology that is accredited by either the Council on Academic Accreditation in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology of ASHA or the Accreditation Council for Audiology Education of the American Academy of Audiology (AAA)."
