Its programs presently have 350 students that include Mothers-Day-Out for 2s through 4-year-olds, a lower school, middle school and upper school through 12th grade.

Summary Job Description

The youth in grades 6-12 will be the primary focus of our Youth & Family Minister, however, he will also be accountable for the establishment of new initiatives and enhancement of current activities that increase the involvement of all our young families with children.

We are seeking a mature Christian man, married, with a minimum of a 4-year degree preferably from a recognized Christian University and/or with church ministry experience. Salary is negotiable.

Winchester Youth Group (WYG) and Family Involvement

1. Plan activities for spiritual development in concert with our youth deacons involved with our youth and with approval of the Eldership.
2. Teach teen Bible classes and choose materials approved by Elders.
3. Author and publish newsletter for teens.
4. Coordinate with and involve parents of youth in church related activities.
5. Plan, coordinate and manage vacation bible school and summer youth camp.
6. Plan and coordinate youth trips to Evangelism University, CYC, and out of town missions.
7. Develop service activities that provide enhanced youth spirituality while helping the needy.
8. Plan and coordinate appropriate social activities with youth deacons and parent volunteers.
9. Plan youth budget and maintain WYG checking account; accounting for all monies spent.
10. Conduct chapel and teach Bible at WCA as needed with prior approval from Eldership.

Ministerial Duties

1. Deliver sermons when scheduled and when Minister is away.
2. Coordinate schedule to ensure that one minister is always onsite during church office hours.
3. Consider our pulpit minister as your mentor; establishing a close-working relationship.

Congregational Care

1. Meet and greet members and visitors as they arrive for services.
2. Visit and encourage congregation's families with children.
3. Minister to members of the congregation who are shut-ins and or sick, infirmed.
4. Attend visitation or funerals for those of our congregation who have lost family.
5. Teach classes when requested to any age group as directed by Elders.
6. Help lead and motivate a personal evangelism program with a goal of soul winning for Jesus and restoration of wayward members.
7. Plan and implement local youth outreach initiatives.
8. Reach out to young visitors and WCA students and invite them to WYG activities.
9. Ask the Elder over Administration for approval of any personal time off or time away when church office is open.
